❖ *abolish old cars*

- Problem: cars are one of the main producers of fossil fuels. The release of CO₂ is different between petrol and diesel vehicles: a daily production of a petrol car is about 133 g/km while in a diesel one the total amount is of 122 g/km. - Advantage: decrease of pollution, better lifestyle



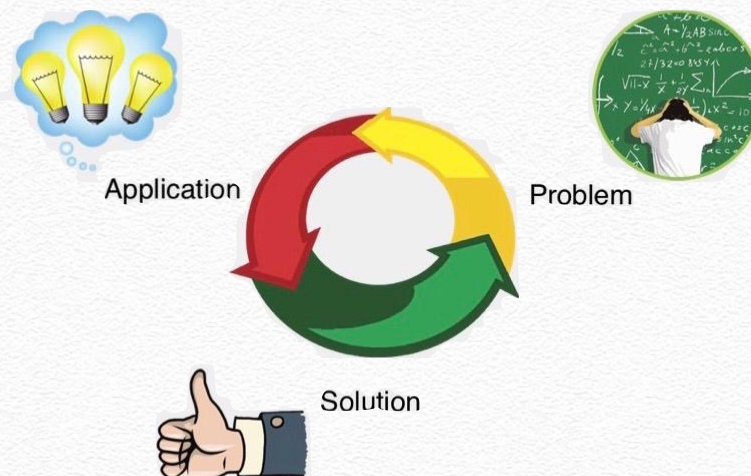
❖ *efficient public transports*

❖ *smart working*

❖ *recycled paper*
