WASTE COLLECTION

GAS EMANATION FROM COWS

They pollute like a car but are not mechanical, they do not need gas but live on grass. They are cows and cattle in general. According to the FAO, livestock which also includes pigs, sheep, goats and other animals are responsible for around 14.5 percent of global greenhouse gas emissions. And cattle contribute for the most part, because they emit from 100 to 140 kilograms of methane per year. Which for the record is a very pernicious gas, more than carbon dioxide: it has a 25 times higher polluting potential than the greenhouse effect and a 30 times greater capacity to retain the heat, even if it is much less present in the atmosphere. So to reduce the pollution it is necessary to decrease the level of intensive farming of these animals.
