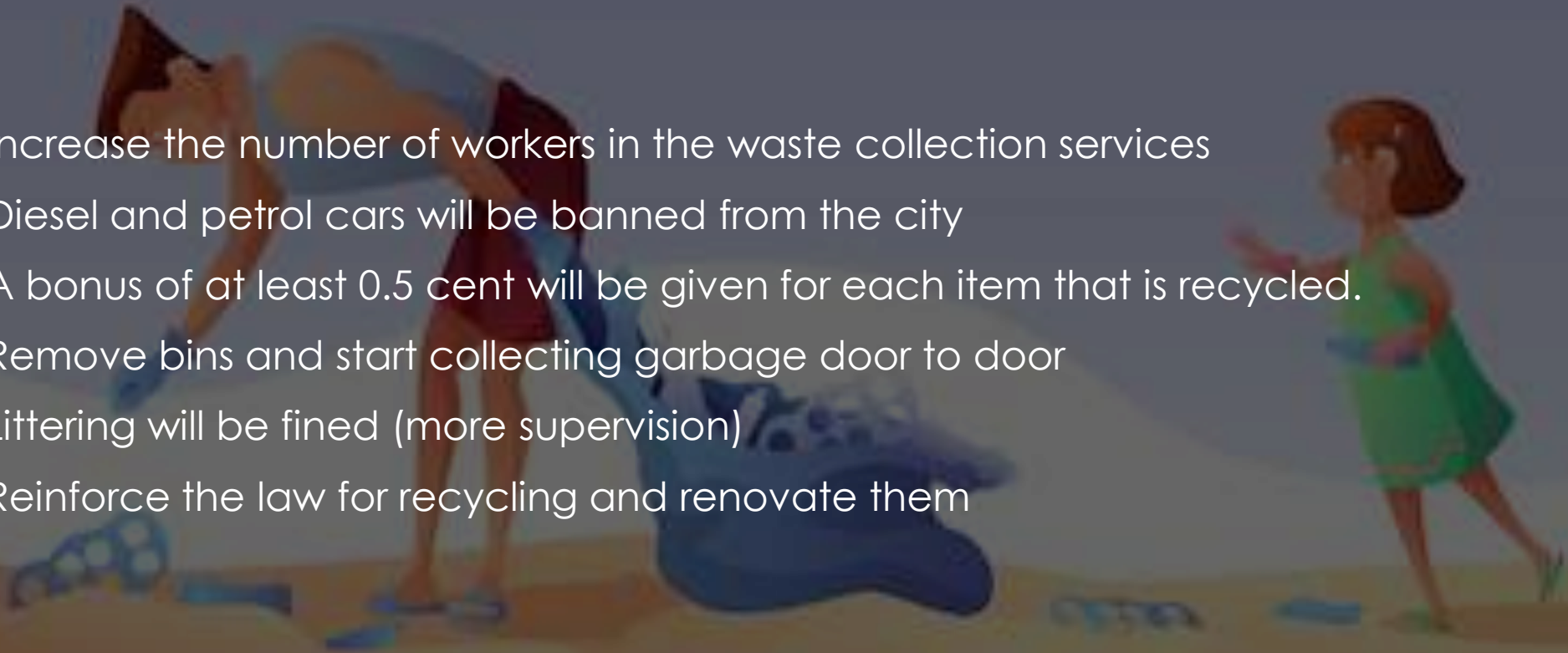


Cleaning Rome

Ideas

- ▶ Increase the number of workers in the waste collection services
- ▶ Diesel and petrol cars will be banned from the city

- ▶ Littering will be fined (more supervision)

- ▶ This would happen adding a special fund of at least 500,000 euros which will be used to buy new machinery for waste collection.

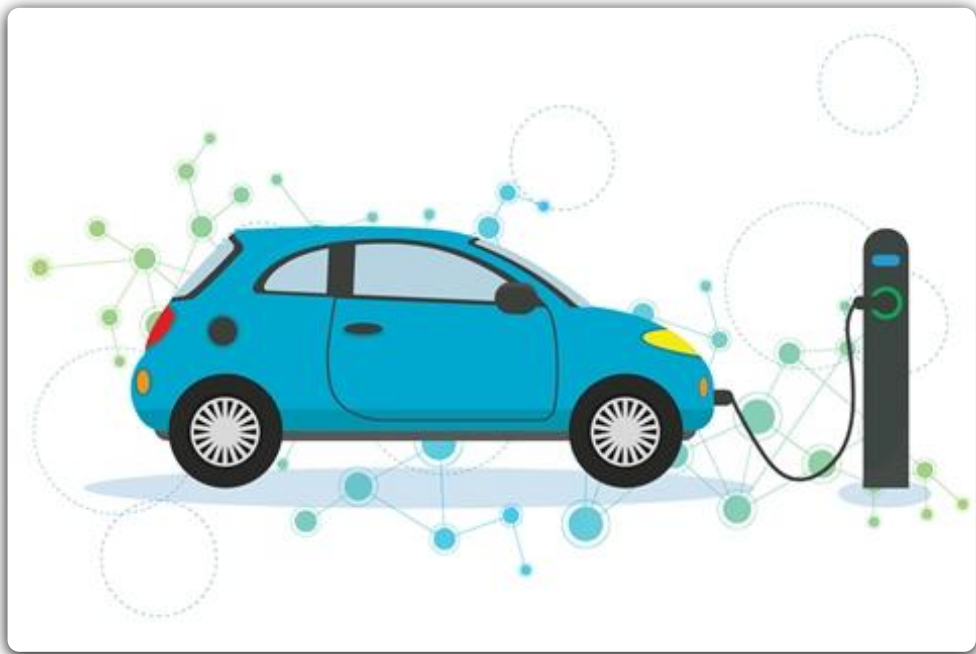




Banning diesel and petrol cars

Facilitate the spread of electric cars



- ▶ In order to facilitate the spread of electric cars, the number of electric columns on the streets will be increased and the prices of bills will be reduced if you want to build your own electric column at home



Improve waste collection

- ▶ We will give a bonus of at least 0.5 cents for each item that will be recycled by a citizen and we will use a fund of 500.000 euros to increase the number of machines involved in waste collection.
- ▶ We will remove the bins from the street and start using door-to-door collection of waste, leaving on the streets only urban baskets.



Littering
